Instructions for the preparation of the abstract

● **Make sure that the presentation title, the author(s) and the affiliation(s) are exactly the same as what you provided when you registered for the presentation.**

● Abstract must be in A4 format, not more than 2 pages (The 3rd page and later will be removed).

● Top margin: 35 mm; bottom, left and right margins: 25 mm

● Begin the first page with the presentation title, author(s) and affiliation(s), followed by a 100-word abstract. Mark the presenting author by a white circle (○).

● Font should be Times or Times New Roman. The font size should be 10.5pt (except for the presentation title that should be bold, 11.5pt).

● Convert your abstract file to PDF and submit it through the submission system. Embed all the fonts (Make sure in the “Font” tab of “Document Properties” on Acrobat that all the fonts appear as “Embedded Subset”).

● Only a PDF file up to 2MB (unprotected, no password) is acceptable.

● Submission deadline: **Friday, June 28th (JST)**.

● The all copyrights of the abstract, including the right for its translation and adaptation, and the original copyright holder's right for the use of its derivative works, shall belong to the Japanese Liquid Crystal Society.
